You must do this daily during sunrise, noontime, afternoon, sunset, and evenings.

This is the first duty of a Muslim, and a person becomes a Muslim by saying and believing this.

The end of this is celebrated by Eid, a day of joy and thanksgiving to Allah.

Every Muslim is expected to do this once in their life. It is known as Hajj.
